1. Executive Director's Report Longterm Plan Wishlist Review: Indicate which items are in the Balboa Park Station Area Plan. Change wording for item 6.

Weaver is talking to Steve Jackson of DPW who is working with MTA's Victor Hoen to fix irrigation at Ocean-Phelan Garden. Contractors cleaning up. Weaver told the MTA that the removed memorial tree must be restored. DPW may add more mulch. MTA needs to pull permits to build bathroom. MTA will give funds for restoring garden. Landscaper Jasmine Kaw will make a plan.

Weaver asked Rick Kurylo of OEWD to make OAA district part of SFShines. A block must be chosen. It involves a \$30,000 grant.

The Sidewalk Garden grant was reduced by half to \$10,000. Installation will likely occur in early 2014. Weaver will talk to Valero about improving landscaping.

2. Ocean Avenue Arts and Culture Festival Picar spoke to Whole Foods. They want to bring a food truck and do a raffle, booths, etc. Will try to do Nickels for Nonprofits in August for the festival. Tree Frog Treks confirmed. Slowly getting tablers. Yama Sushi interested. Poster design in. Peter's Kettle Corn. Need more volunteers. Approached Walgreens, CVS, Seligman, SFPOA, Chase, for sponsorship. The YMCA will do its usual \$500. OMICC getting \$2000. Macy's giving \$2000. Picar will work on getting money from Yee's office. Entertainment lined up.

Performance Mic Fundraiser for festival will be July 27th from 7-9. Trying to get comedians.

3. 270 Brighton Development The project will go before the Planning Commission soon. CleanScapes complained about the lot. Weaver told the developer it should be cleaned.

4. Street Event Project Planning OAA should fund small events with \$500 grants.
