**3. Executive Director's Report** The Ocean-Phelan Garden is still in flux. There's an agreement for the MTA to bring out irrigation specialists to fix what's wrong. MTA will connect the trees with irrigation and will provide more plants and replacement cherry tree. Weaver is pushing the shed. Should happen in two months. MTA is waiting on the building permit for the driver bathrooms.

CCSF Landscaping: Weaver spoke to CleanScapes. They came up with a plan to add mulch. The plan could involve volunteers. At the moment, it costs \$1,500.

Historic Preservation Plan: Mullaney and Weaver met with Planning Director John Raihm. His staff said they had a report made 5 years ago. They may have to redo the study.

Parklet: Grant has not been awarded yet.

SFShines: Talked to OEWD about assisting small businesses. Not only about SFShines but getting grants. Asked about painting Ingleside Presbyterian. OEWD suggested OAA create a grant to have church painted. SFShines only works with small businesses.
