- OAA Historic Streetcar Charter On Sunday 10-22-17 at Castro and Market, Muni's 1912 Car No. 1 will pick up OAA members and friends to go on a round trip down Market Street and the Embarcadero to Fisherman's Wharf and back to Castro. Be there at the start time, 1:45 pm. This is the third year we have had a historic streetcar tour event.
- Unity Plaza OAA is organizing a 3rd Unity Plaza event, Ocean Air Market, on the second Sunday of November, 11-12-17. We are working with Dahlia Community Engagement and the San Francisco Arts Commission. The November event will focus on a group of curated arts and crafts vendors and live music. On 12-10-17 OAA is partnering with OMI Cultural Participation Project to present a Holiday crafts market at Unity Plaza.
- Ocean Avenue Sculpture Project We have given up on the Phelan and Geneva site and are seeking to use the available grant funding for a sculptor-designed library gate on the Ocean Ave sidewalk between the library garden and the Avalon Bay site.
- Balboa BART Station Area Cleaning: No response from BART yet.
- Legacy Business Program Luis and Neil have been working to expand the number of Ocean Avenue's legacy businesses. Current Ocean Avenue Legacy Businesses are Beep's Burgers, Faxon Garage, The Ave Bar and Ocean Hair Design.
